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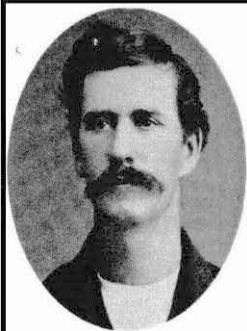

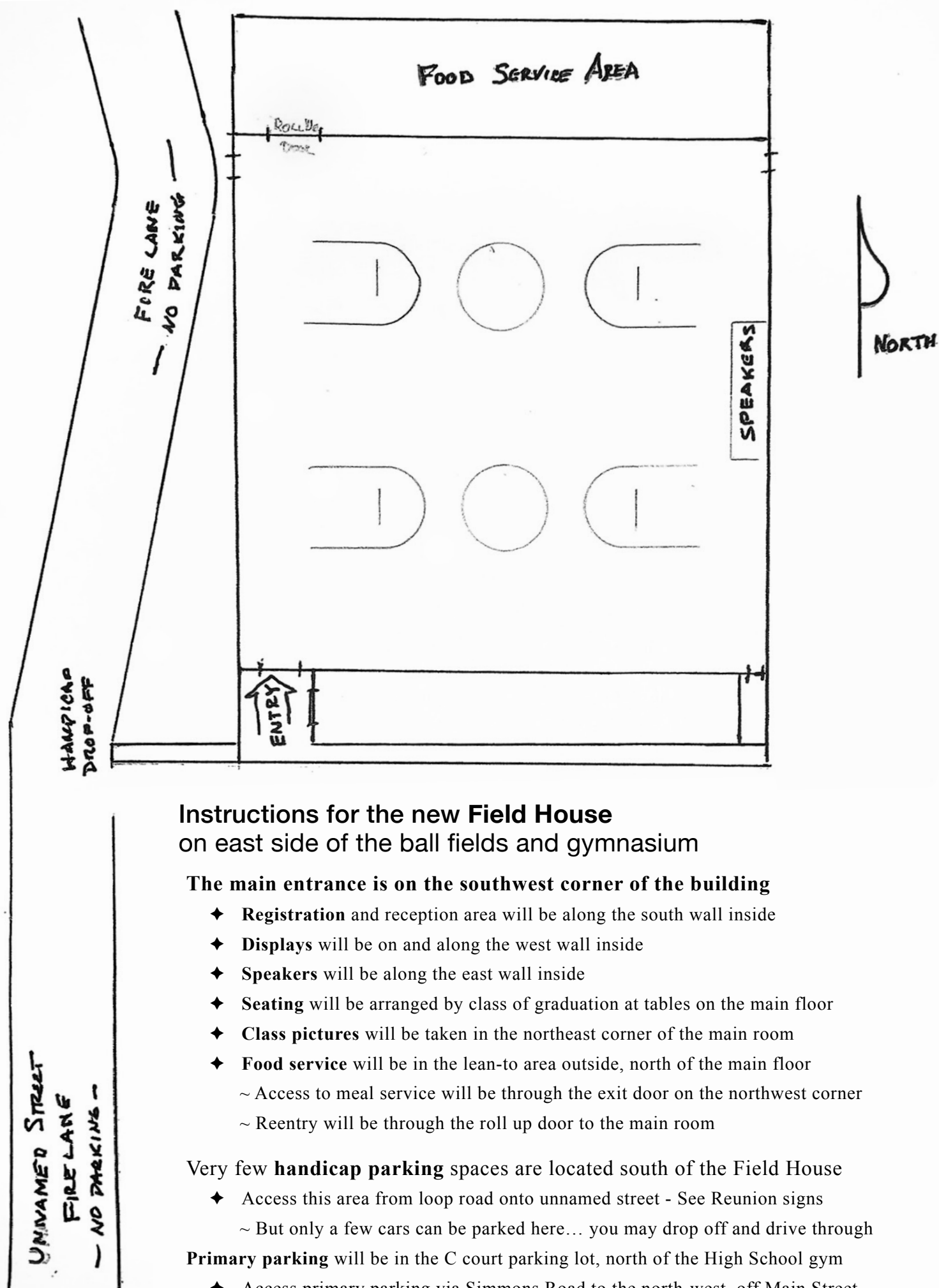

Instructions for the new Field House on east side of the ball fields and gymnasium

The main entrance is on the southwest corner of the building

- ◆ Registration and reception area will be along the south wall inside
- ◆ Displays will be on and along the west wall inside
- ◆ Speakers will be along the east wall inside
- ◆ Seating will be arranged by class of graduation at tables on the main floor
- ◆ Class pictures will be taken in the northeast corner of the main room
- ◆ Food service will be in the lean-to area outside, north of the main floor
 - ~ Access to meal service will be through the exit door on the northwest corner
 - ~ Reentry will be through the roll up door to the main room

Very few handicap parking spaces are located south of the Field House

- ◆ Access this area from loop road onto unnamed street - See Reunion signs
 - ~ But only a few cars can be parked here... you may drop off and drive through

Primary parking will be in the C court parking lot, north of the High School gym

- ◆ Access primary parking via Simmons Road to the north-west, off Main Street north of the intersection with Loop Road (near Snowden Road)

Overflow parking will be where we have parked in recent years, between the Middle School and High School

- ◆ A long walk through the CHS campus and around the ball fields to the new Field House, east of the baseball fields and the gymnasium

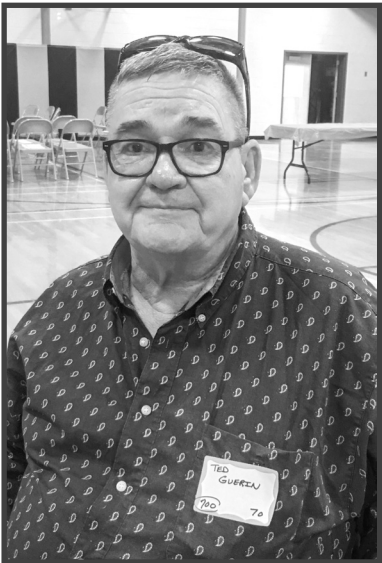
